Week 2—Tuning In To the Spirit  
Text: John 14:16–17

John 14:16–17 (NIV) *“And I will pray to the Father, and he will give you another comforter, that will be with you forever—the Spirit of Truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.”*

*Intro:* In order for us to grow as Christians we must learn to be in tune with the voice of the Holy Spirit. As we allow the Holy Spirit to become a part of our daily lives, he comes into the day to day operations of our life. When this begins to happen (and we allow him), transformation really begins to take place. Over time we find ourselves involving the Holy Spirit into our thoughts, decisions, and actions. This is the ultimate goal of the Spirit-filled life.

*Powerful Point:* God wants us to develop spiritual ears to hear the Holy Spirit.

Tuning In To the Spirit:

**Teaches—** The Holy Spirit will teach us all things.

(John 14:26, 1 Corinthians 2:9-13)

**Uplifts—** He encourages us to live a pure and holy life.

(Galatians 5:25, Romans 14:17)

**Nurtures—** He helps us grow and walk in God’s Word and will.

(John 16:13)

**Empowers—** He gives us boldness for serving God’s kingdom.

(Acts 1:8)
